The 25th Dhaka International Yarn & Fabric Show (DIYFS) 2026 Winter Edition, held alongside the 8th Dhaka International Denim Show 2026, concluded at the International Convention City (ICC) in Dhaka after four days of vibrant global participation.

Jointly organized by CEMS-Global USA and CCEP-TEX (Sub-Council of Textile Industry, China Council for the Promotion of International Trade), the exhibition took place from 28 to 31 January 2026. The milestone event marked the 25th anniversary of Bangladesh's long-standing B2B yarn and fabric sourcing platform.

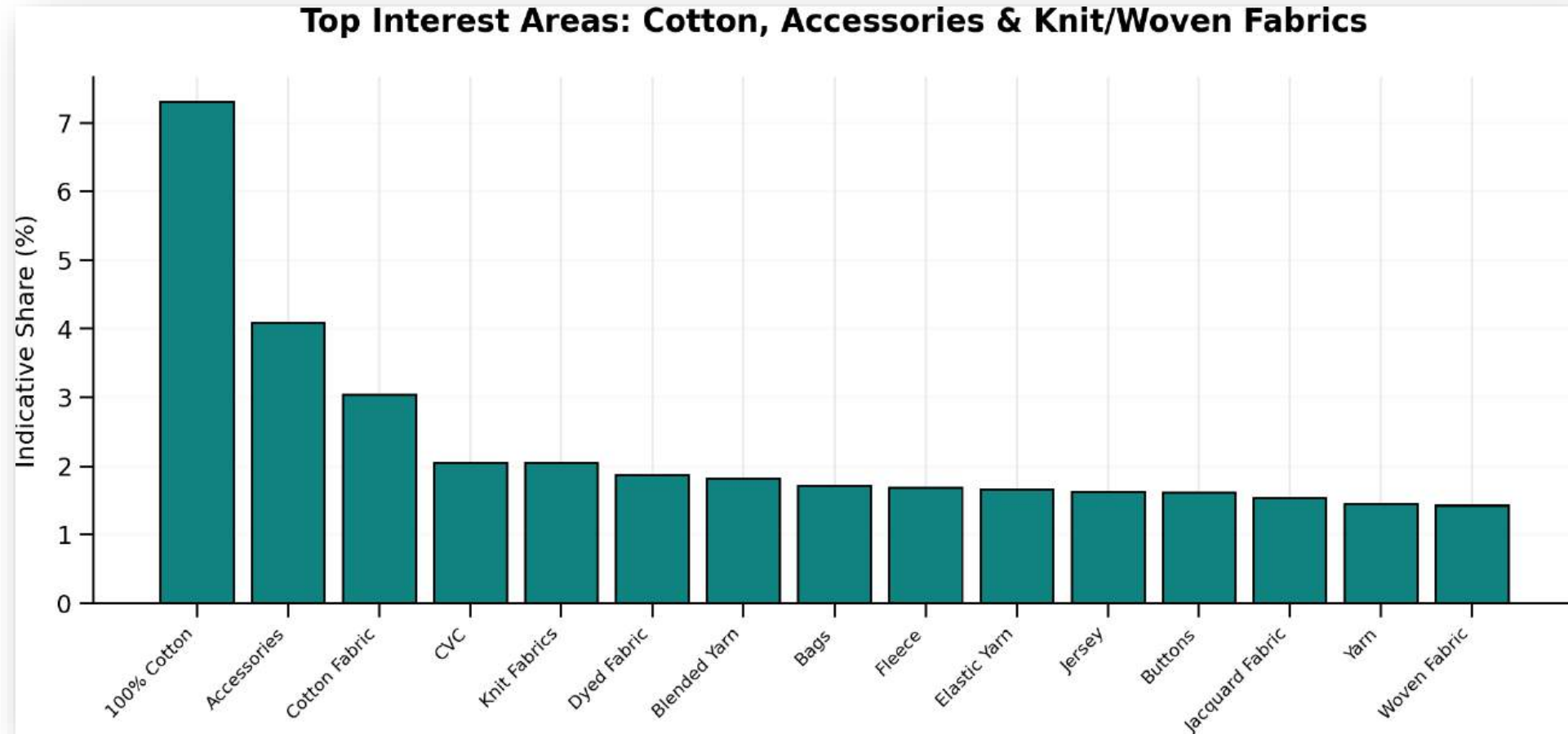

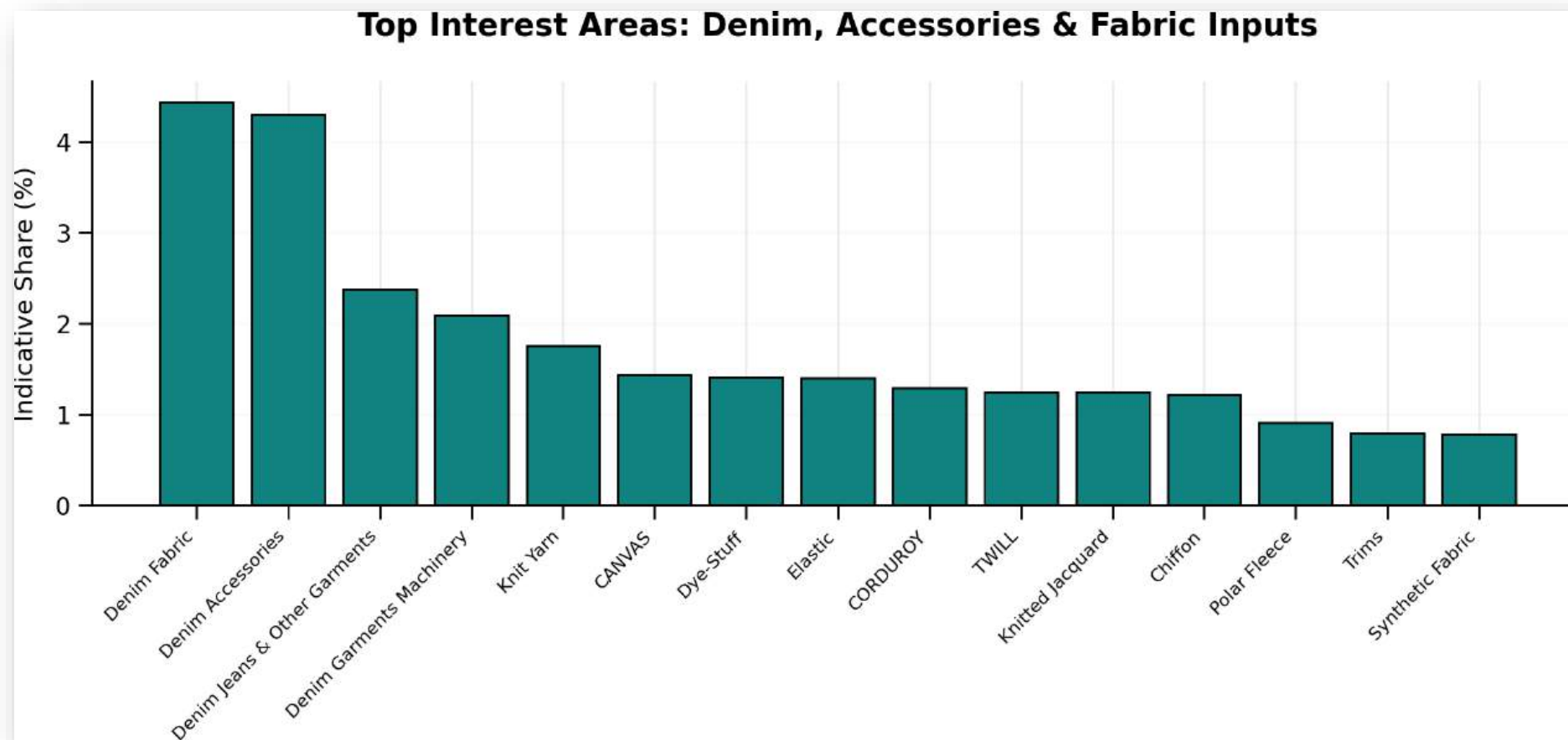

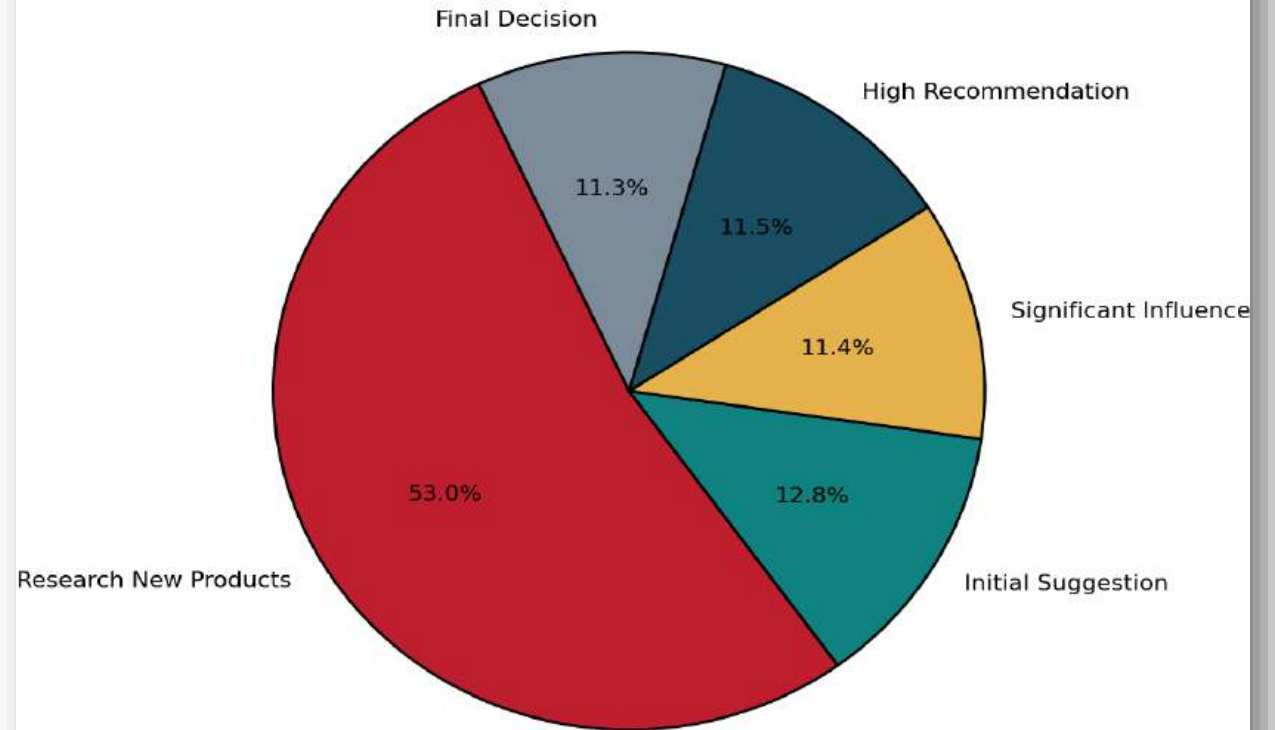


Visitor Role in Buying Decisions

Decision Influence Breakdown

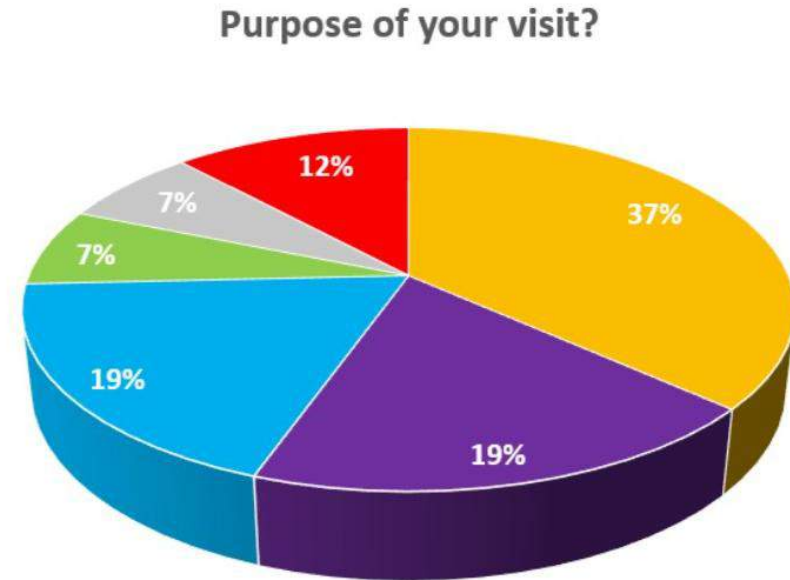

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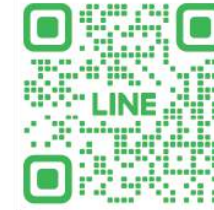
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
